



Liberal House Moore opens

THE opening of the Liberal House Moore has provided an easily accessible face to the Liberal Party in Moora.

Member for the Agricultural Region Brian Ellis said the office would offer a regional facility for visiting Liberal members, a community focus for local residents with government issues, and a link to his Geraldton electorate office.

The office will be manned from 10am to 3pm on Wednesday, Thursday and Friday, with a break over the Christmas holiday period.

It is Mr Ellis' intention to attend every second Friday allowing residents to have personal contact with their local MP.

"As a third generation farmer from Bindi Bindi and a former deputy shire president I already have strong links to the Moora district," he said.

"Whilst I have always maintained the interests of the Moore area in the parliament, I am looking forward with great pleasure to contributing again at a localised level.

"The seat of Moore has been held by Liberal members for many years, and a local office is long overdue."

The office was fittingly opened by Norman Moore MLC, who is best known as the Minister for Mines and

Petroleum; Fisheries, but is also the Minister for Electoral Affairs.

Mr Moore acknowledged Mr Ellis as a parliamentary colleague and friend stating that he is a very good member of parliament and does a lot of work for his electorate.

"It is a very good move to have a Liberal office open in Moora as we need to re-assert ourselves in the seat of Moore and recognise that we need a good presence," Mr Moore said.

"As a party we need the community to know that we care about them and provide services for the Moore region.

"The aim is to make sure that conservative governments are running Western Australia."
